Transparency, Protest and Democratic Stability

This folder contains the replication materials for *Transparency, Protest and Democratic Stability*. The original code was written and run in Stata version 11.2. The contents of this folder should consist of the following:

Stata .do Files:

- *Autocratic Reversion Results*
 - **DemCollapse.do** – This file runs all baseline models for which the outcome variable is an indicator for an autocratic reversion. These include all models presented in Table 2 in the text of the text, as well as Figure 1. These also include the robustness checks on the functional form of the estimating equation, presented in Tables 2 and 3 in the Appendix.
 - **DemCollapseType2.do** – This file runs the robustness check using an alternation of democracy (and hence autocratic reversion) as the outcome variable. This alternative definition relaxes the Type2 criterion in the *Democracy and Development* definition of democracy. These results correspond to Table 1 in the Appendix.
 - **BJPSRobustnessChecks.do** – This file runs robustness checks with additional controls. These correspond to the results in Tables 4-8 in the Appendix.
- *Leader Removal Results*
 - **Translrreg.do** – This file runs all models in the text for which leader removal (either regular or irregular) is the outcome term. These include all results in Tables 3 and 4 in the text. The file also runs the Monte Carlo simulations the results of which are reported in Table 5 of the text.
 - **LeaderRemovalRobustness.do** – This file runs models of leader removal with additional controls. These results are reported in Tables 9-18 of the Appendix.

Data Files:

- **FinalSurvival.dta** – These are the data used to analyze the relationship between transparency and autocratic reversions in the text.
- **Type2Reversions.dta** – These are the data analogous to the above, but with an alternative definition of democracy.
- **BJPSRevisionRobustness.dta** – These data are used for the robustness checks in the appendix in which autocratic reversion is the outcome variable.
- **ArchigosPost1980.dta** – These are data from the Archigos dataset, limited to the 1980 period and beyond. These data, merged with FinalSurvival.dta, serve as the basis for the regular/irregular leader removal results.
- **LeadSurvivalBJPSRobustness.dta** – These data are used for the leader survival robustness checks in the Appendix.
